WHO IS CONVICTION GROUP? //

Conviction Group is a non-profit organisation aiming to encourage young males to re-evaluate their perspective on the pivotal issues concerning young men's health and empower enhanced decision-making. We achieve this through our student mentoring programs, school presentations and forums.

OBJECTIVE //

Our objective is to provide students with keynote speakers who possess real stories and unique perspectives on the various issues concerning young men's health. Each keynote speaker has a perspective, which has been drawn from first hand experiences. Following each speaker, small group sessions will be used to reinforce key principles, stimulate discussion between students and provide students with the practical tools to deal with these issues.

SPEAKERS //

The forum utilises expert speakers to inform, engage and influence students on pivotal issues concerning young men's health. These issues include mental health, body image, alcohol fuelled violence, resilience and leadership.

SMALL GROUPS //

Each student will be assigned a group upon registration. Each group will have a maximum of 10 students from different schools. Students will listen to speakers and complete small group sessions in these specific groups. Group leaders are preselected to encourage group cohesion, facilitate discussion, and stimulate engagement. Each group leader possesses leadership experience and has demonstrated a high standard of integrity within their respective community, workplace, university and school.

HOW TO REGISTER? //

STEP 1 - SCHOOL REGISTRATION

In your registration email please provide:

- School name
- The number of students you wish to attend (maximum 15 students per school)
- Corresponding teacher's full name
- Corresponding teacher's contact mobile number
- Corresponding teacher's school email address

STEP 2 - PAYMENT, ATTENDEE DETAILS AND MEDIA PERMISSION

Once the school registration email has been received, schools will receive a return email. Schools will be expected to complete 3 mandatory requirements to finalise registration:

- 1. Payment:** an invoice will be attached to the email for the value of the total number of attendees.
- 2. Attendee Details:** an excel document will be attached to the email. Please complete the document and send the document back to Conviction Group via email.
- 3. Media Permission:** at each forum, we capture parts of the event through photo and video. Due to the size of the event, students may be photographed and/or filmed during the day. All attending students will require media permission. Schools will be required to insert a media permission disclaimer (provided by Conviction Group) into their school permission note.

REGISTRATION CONDITIONS //

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT DUE: Tuesday, 24th of May 2016

Payment: given the limited number of seating and schools attending, booking cancellations after the registration invoice has been generated will still hold the school liable for any outstanding payments.

Students: schools are encouraged to select students that would benefit most from the forum. The day will be strictly limited to 240 students in total. There is a limit of 15 students per school to be accompanied by (a maximum of) 1 teacher per school.

Speakers: whilst all speakers have confirmed at the time of publication, Conviction Group cannot guarantee their attendance; and should they withdraw schools will be notified immediately.

Transport: Conviction Group is not responsible for transport and parking to and from the venue.

Attendee Details: no changes to the student name list can be made after Friday, 3rd of June.


